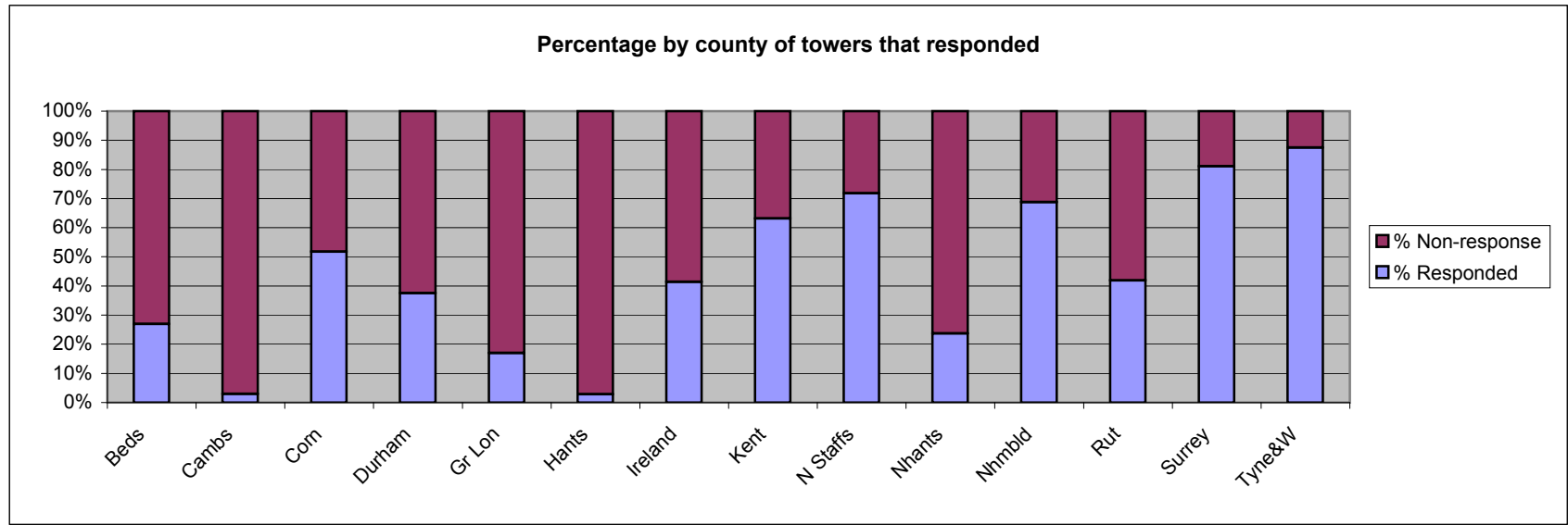
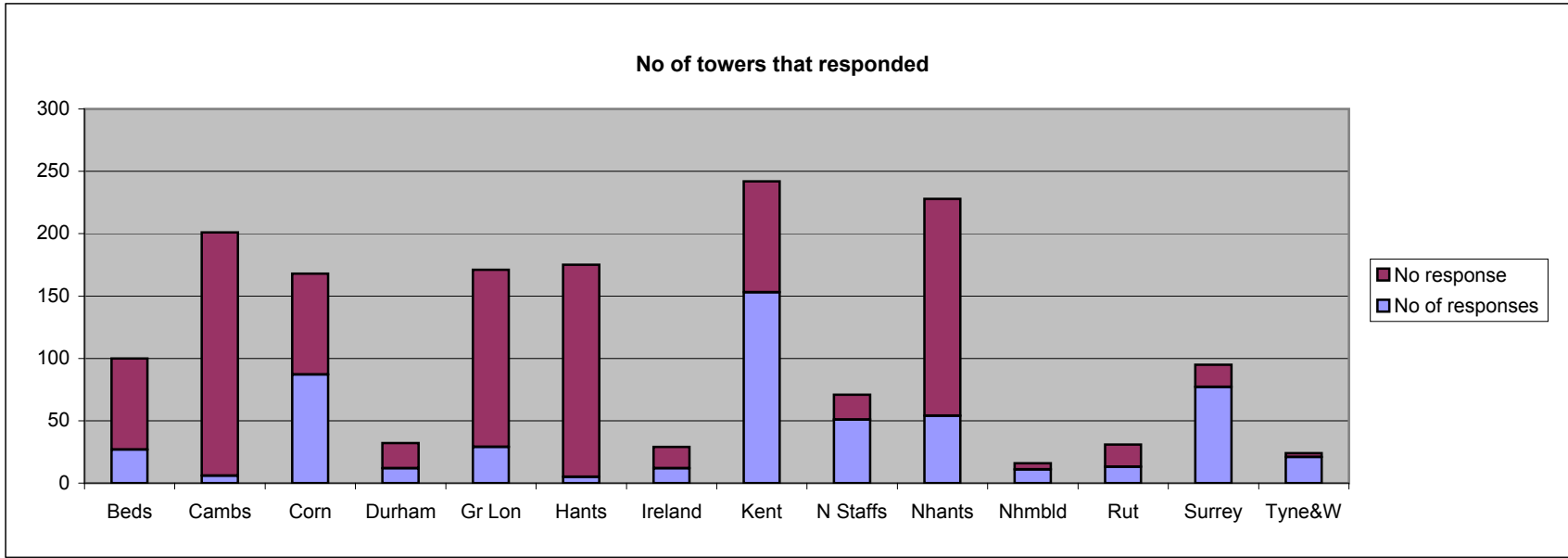


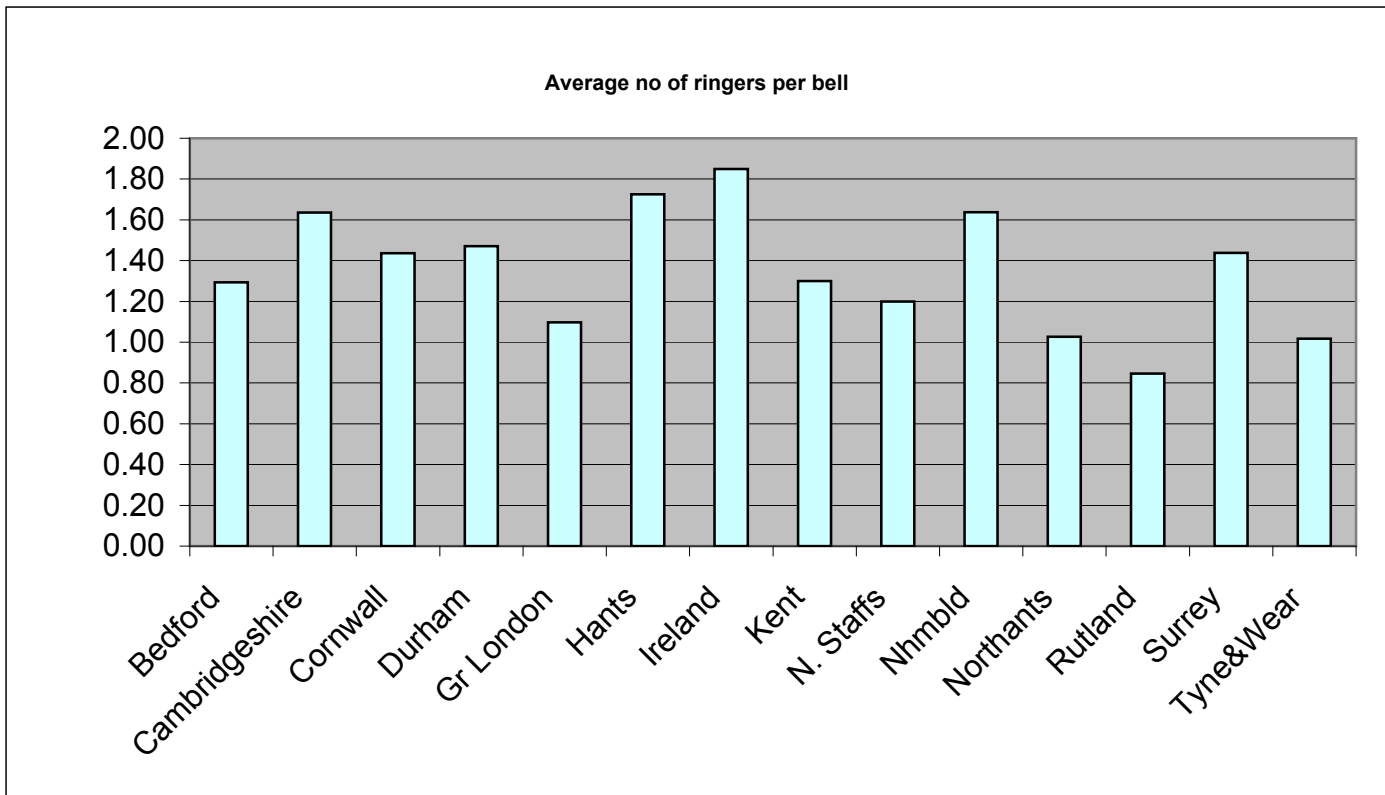

**Q1: How many ringers are there in your band?**

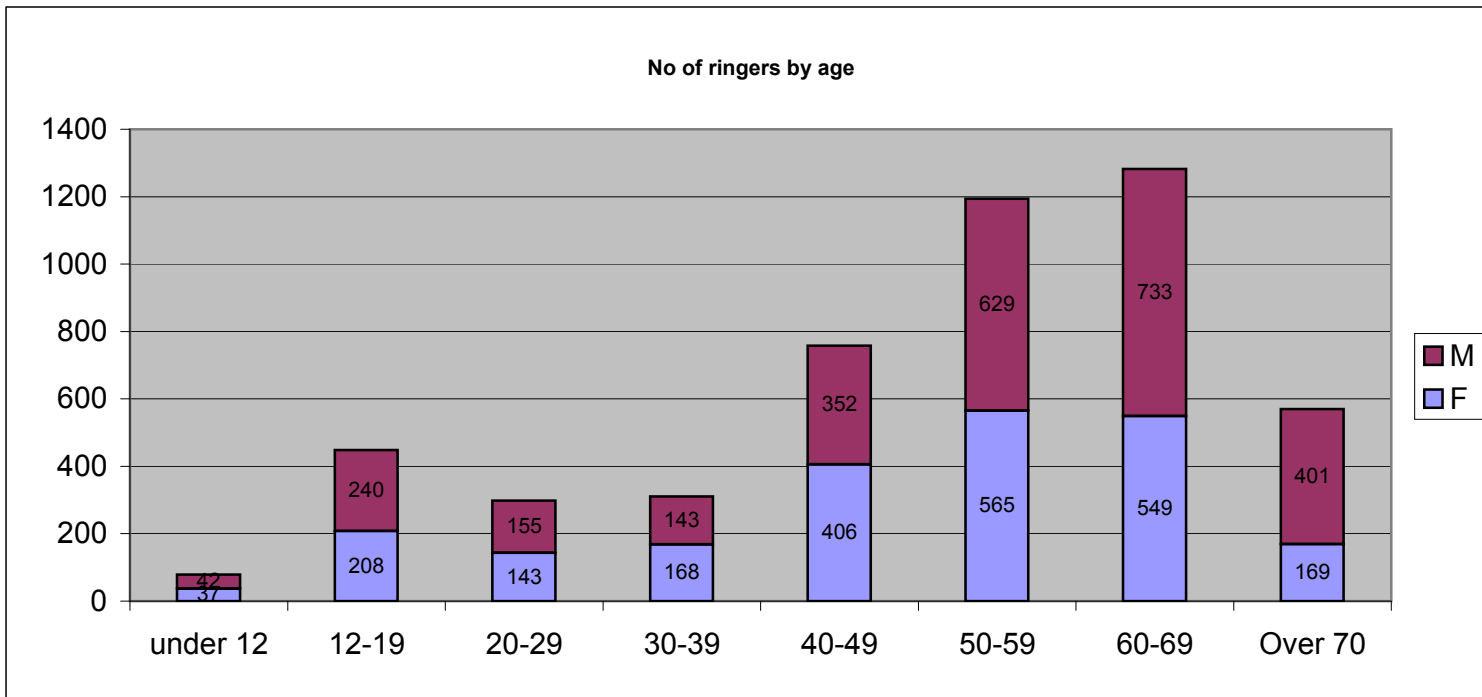

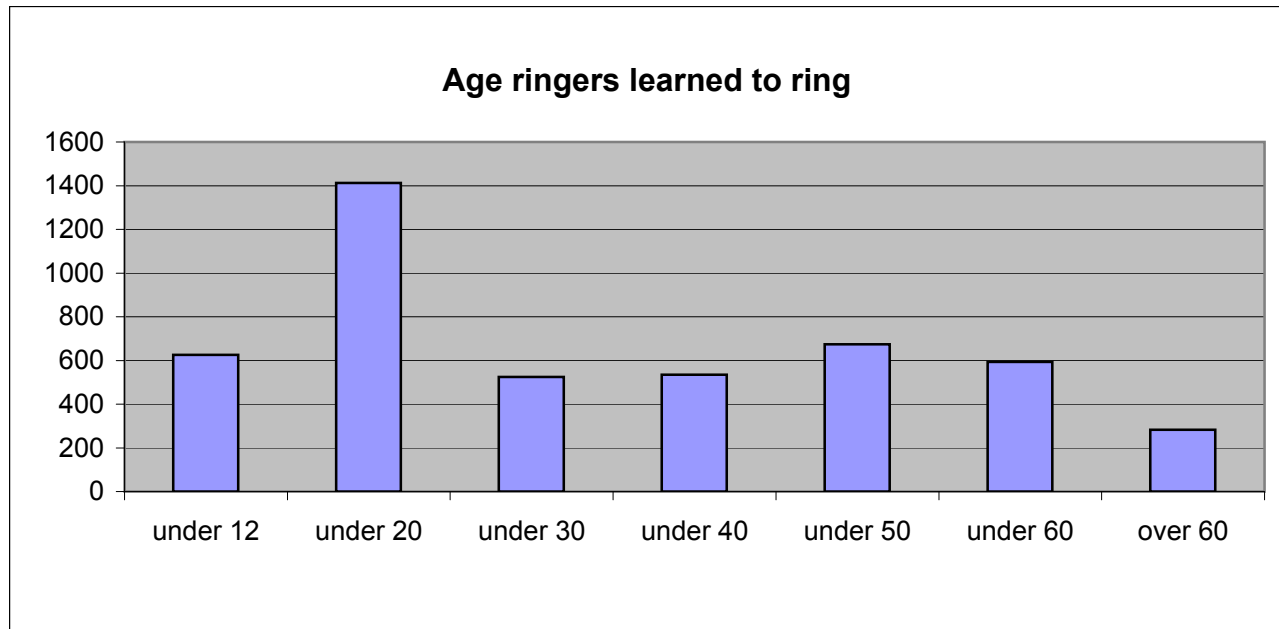

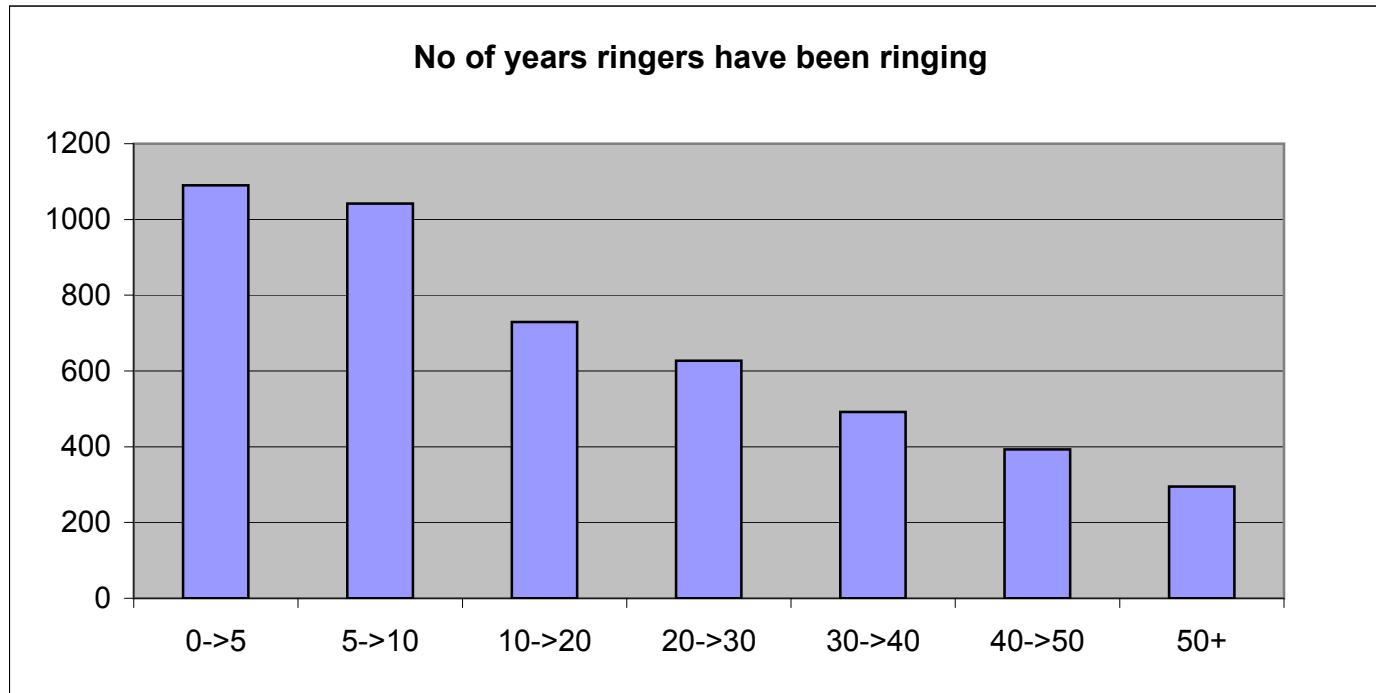

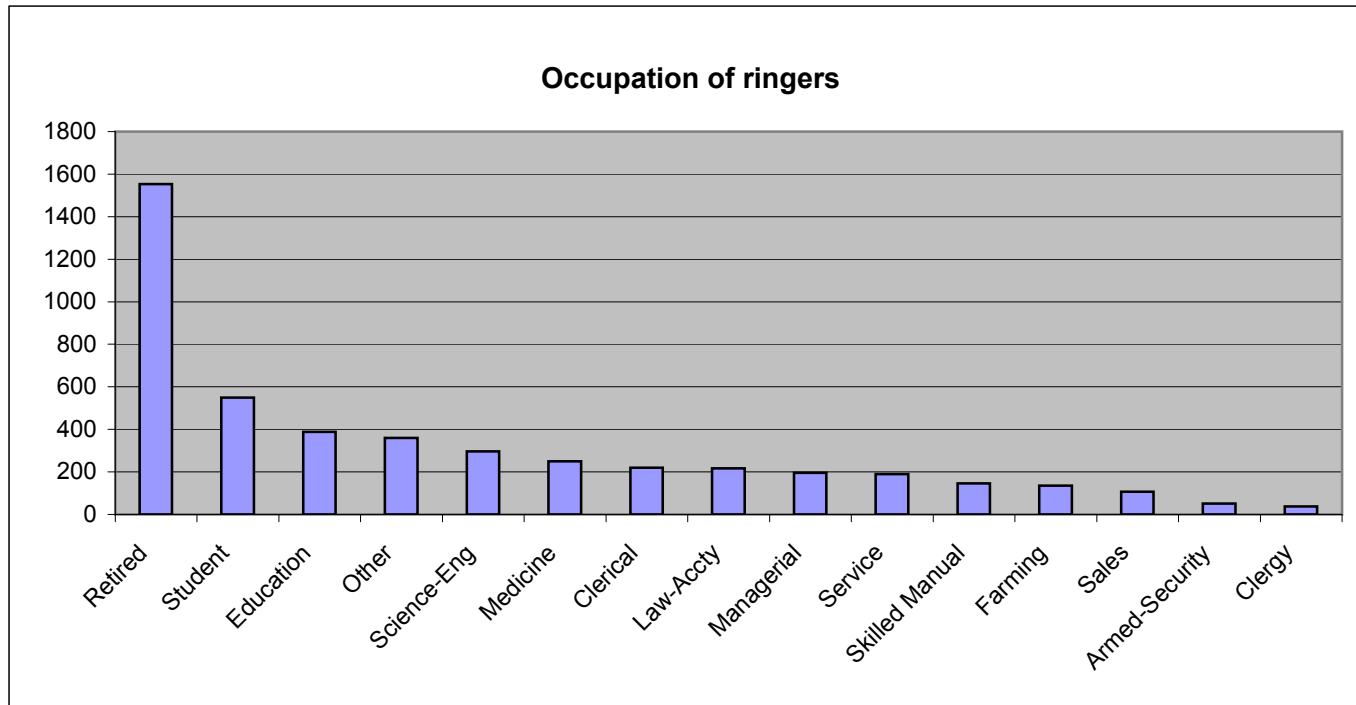

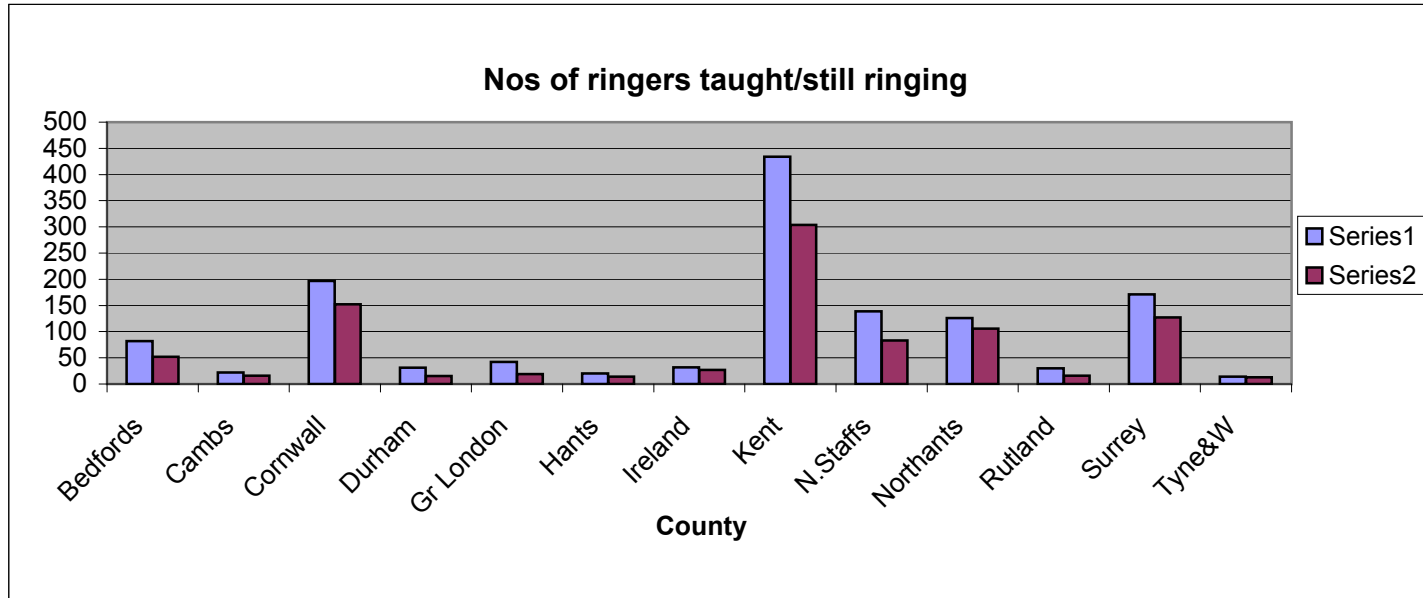

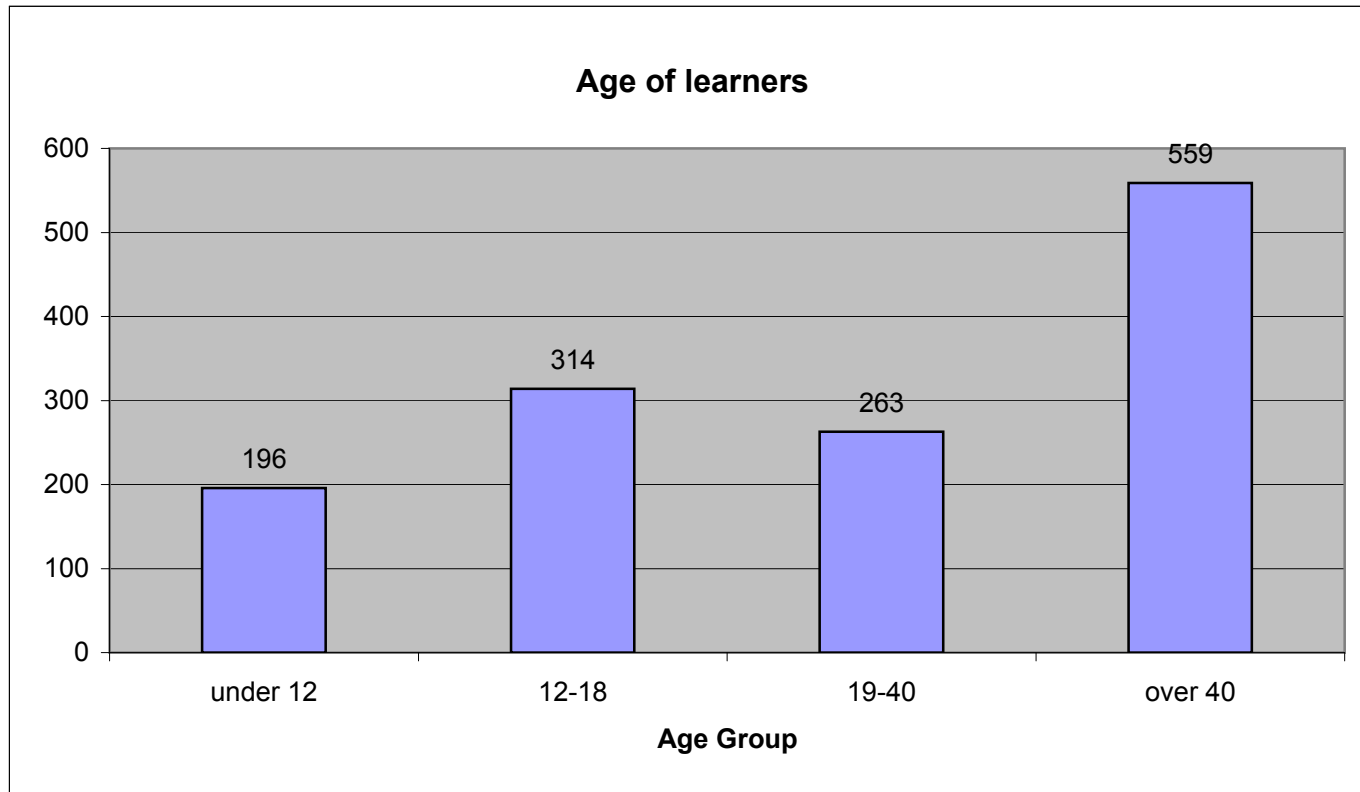
